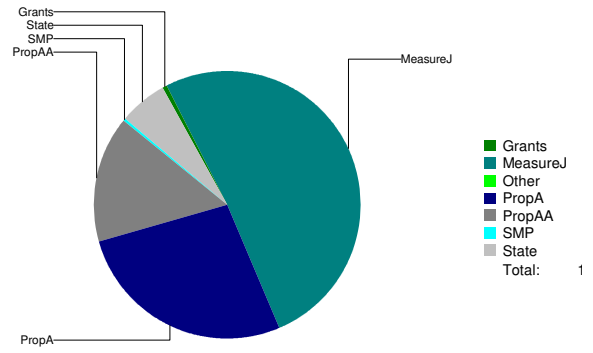
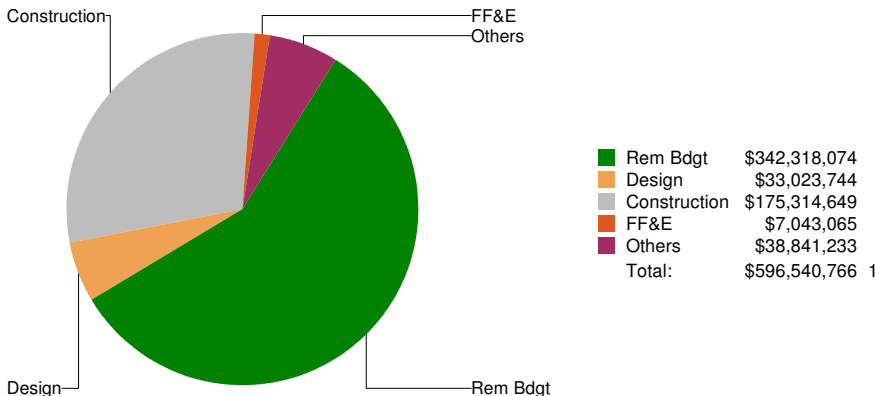

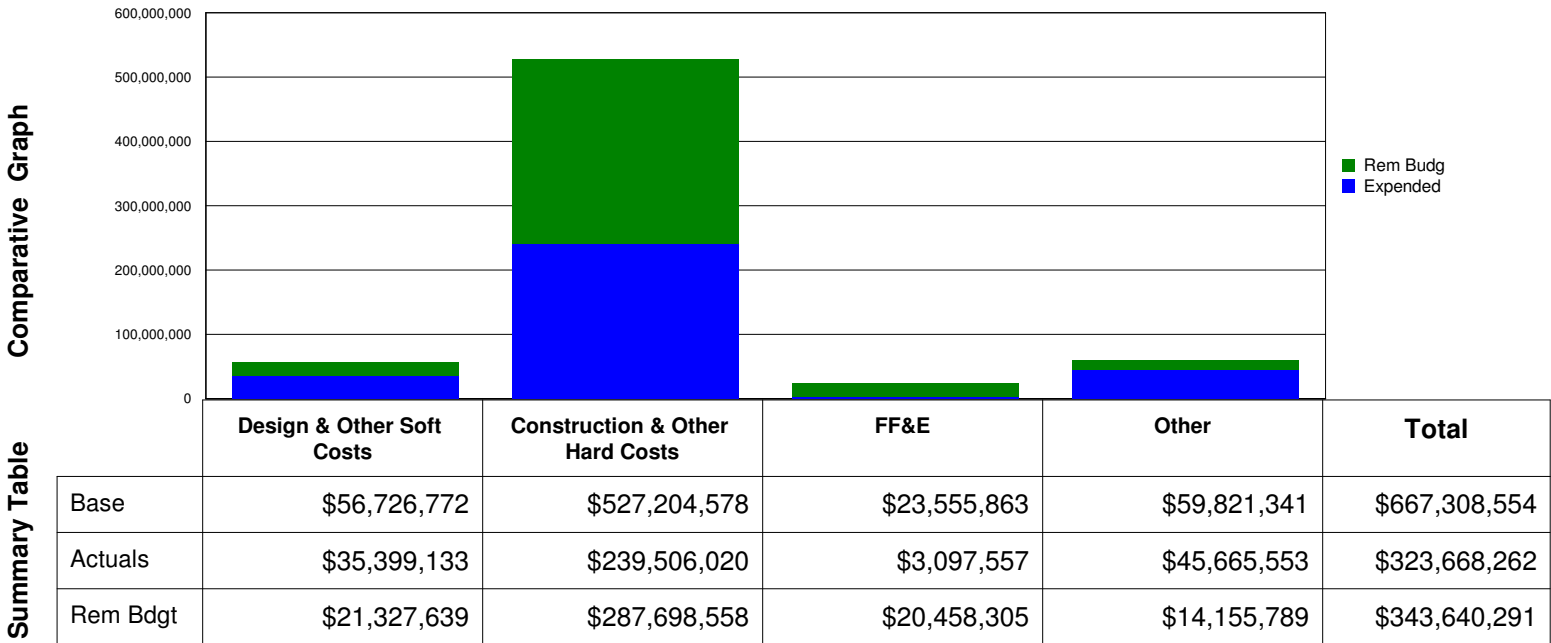
East Los Angeles College

Description:

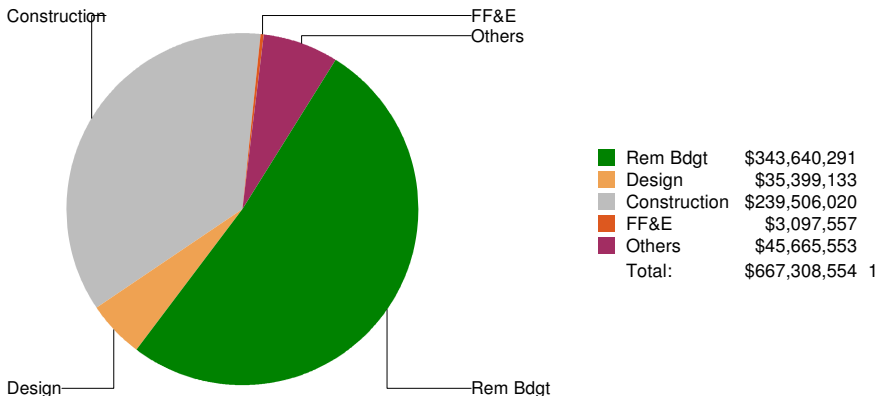

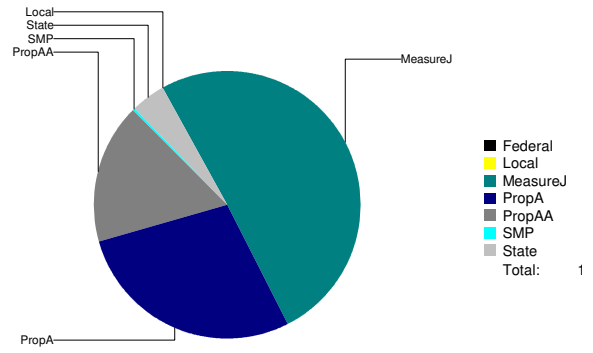

Los Angeles Harbor College

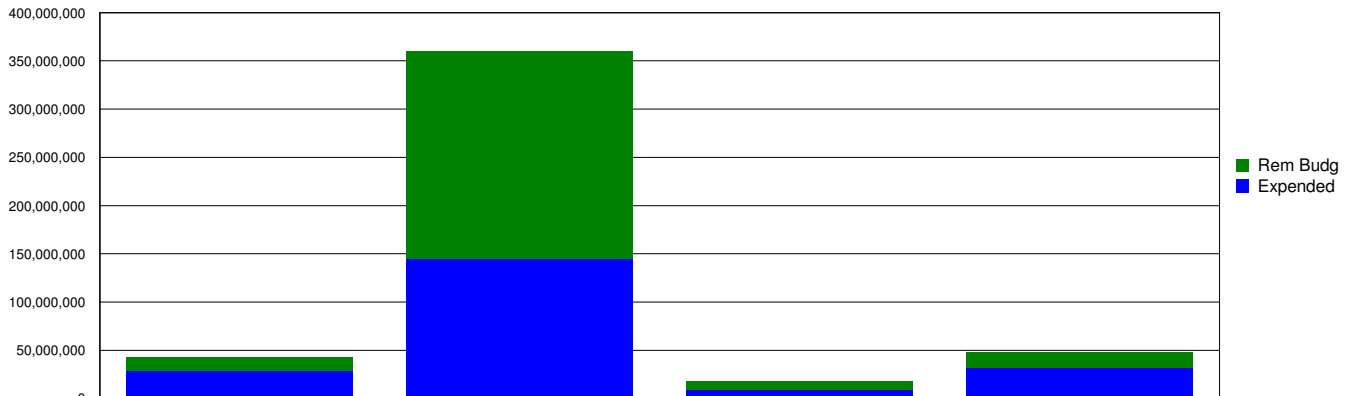
Description:

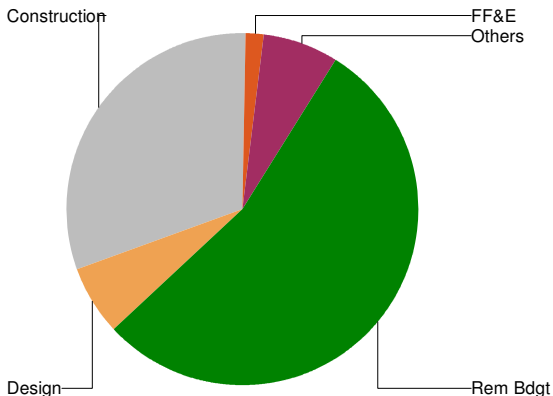

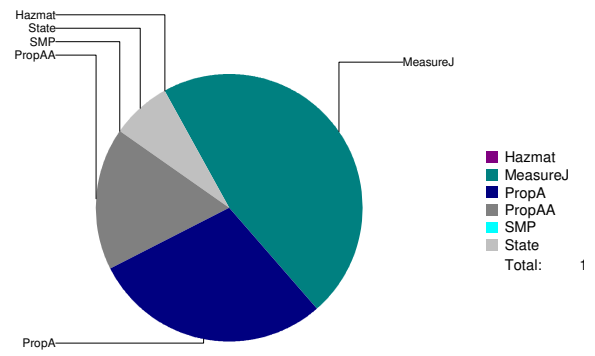

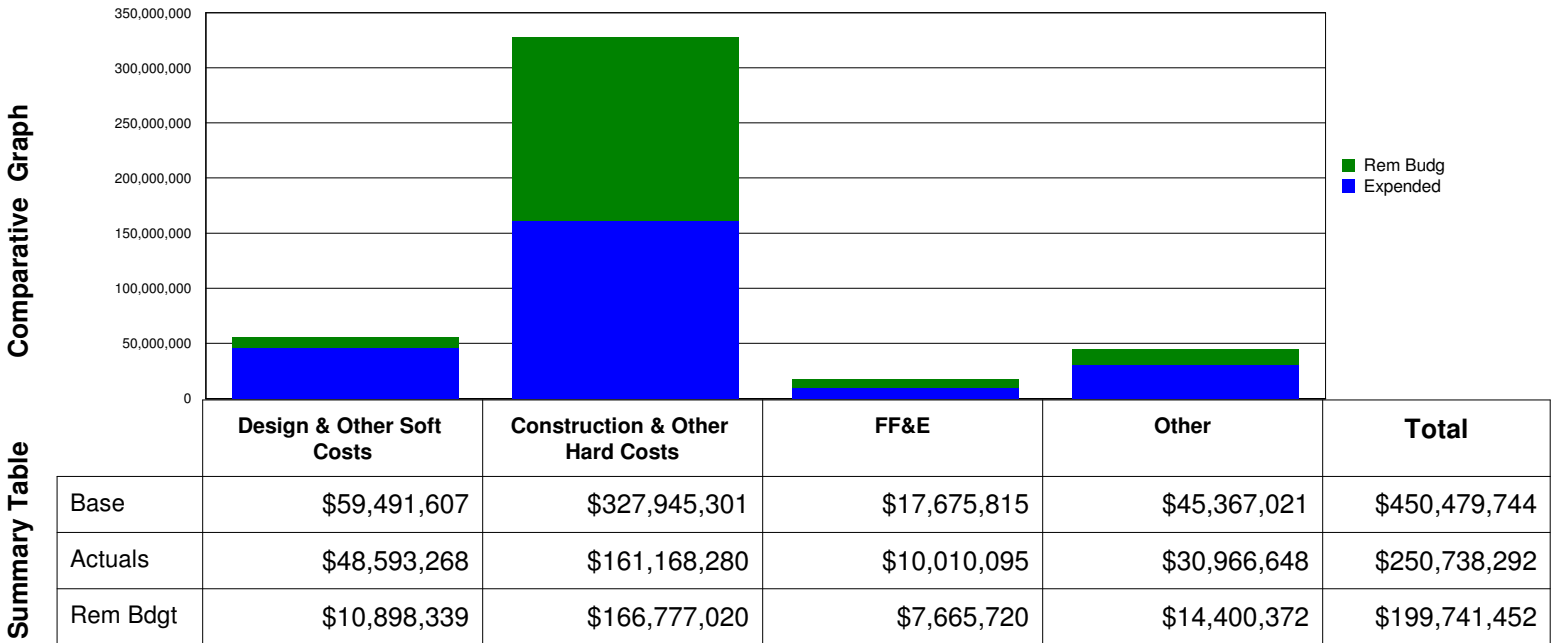
Los Angeles Mission College

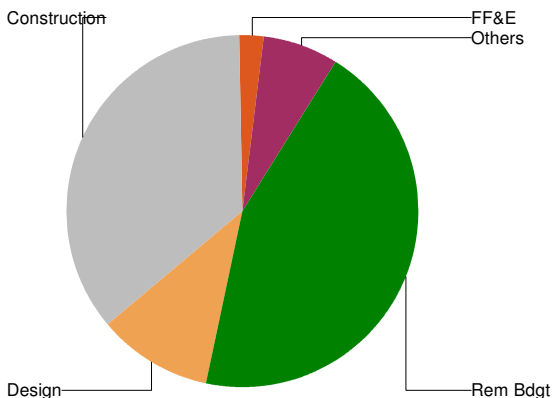

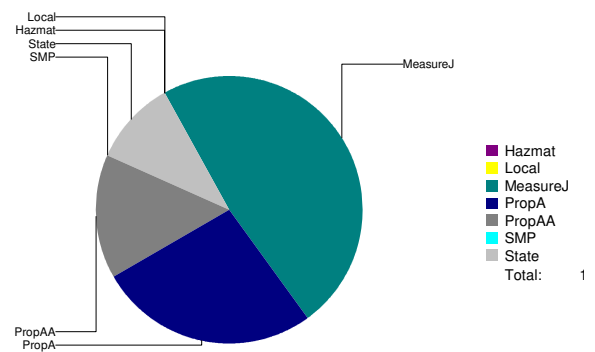

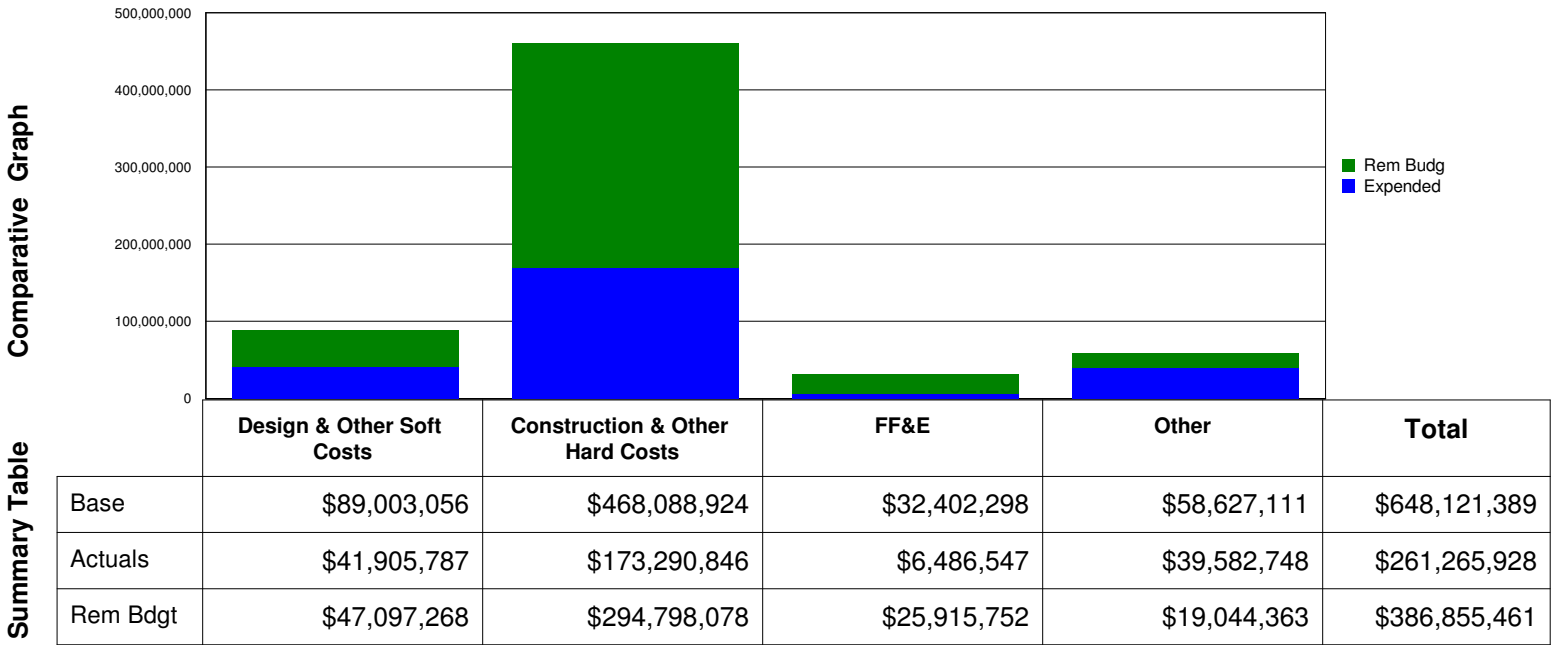
Pierce College

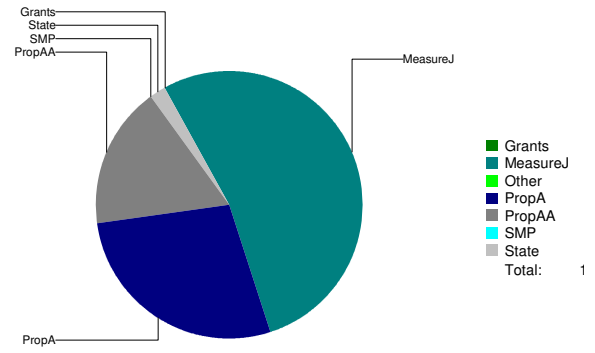
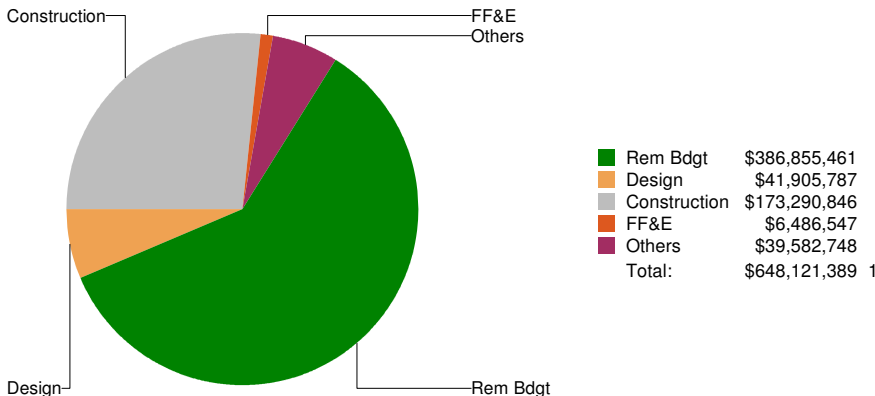

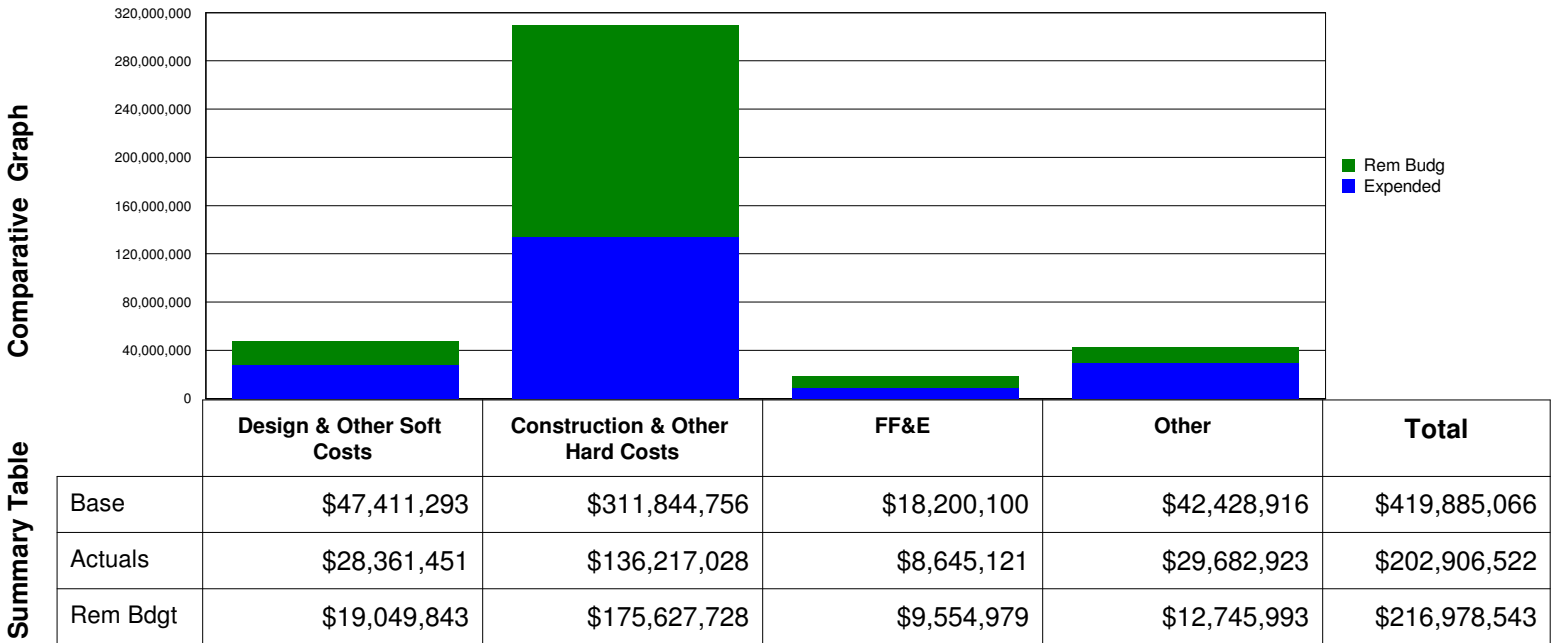
Los Angeles Southwest College

Description:

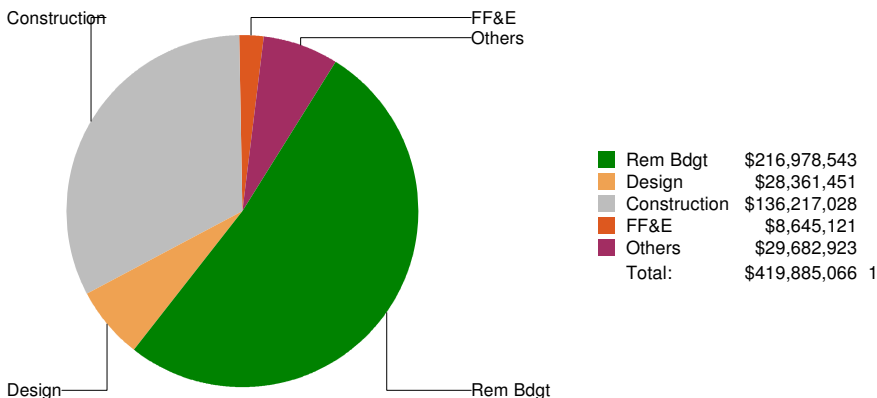

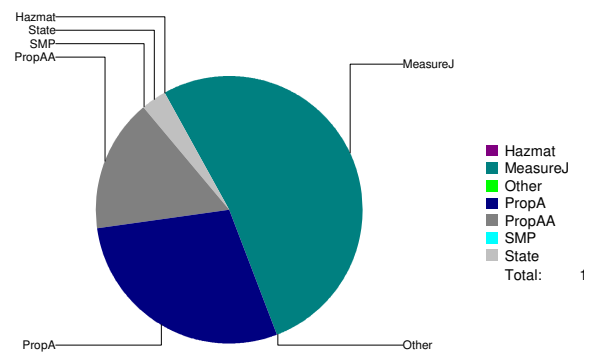

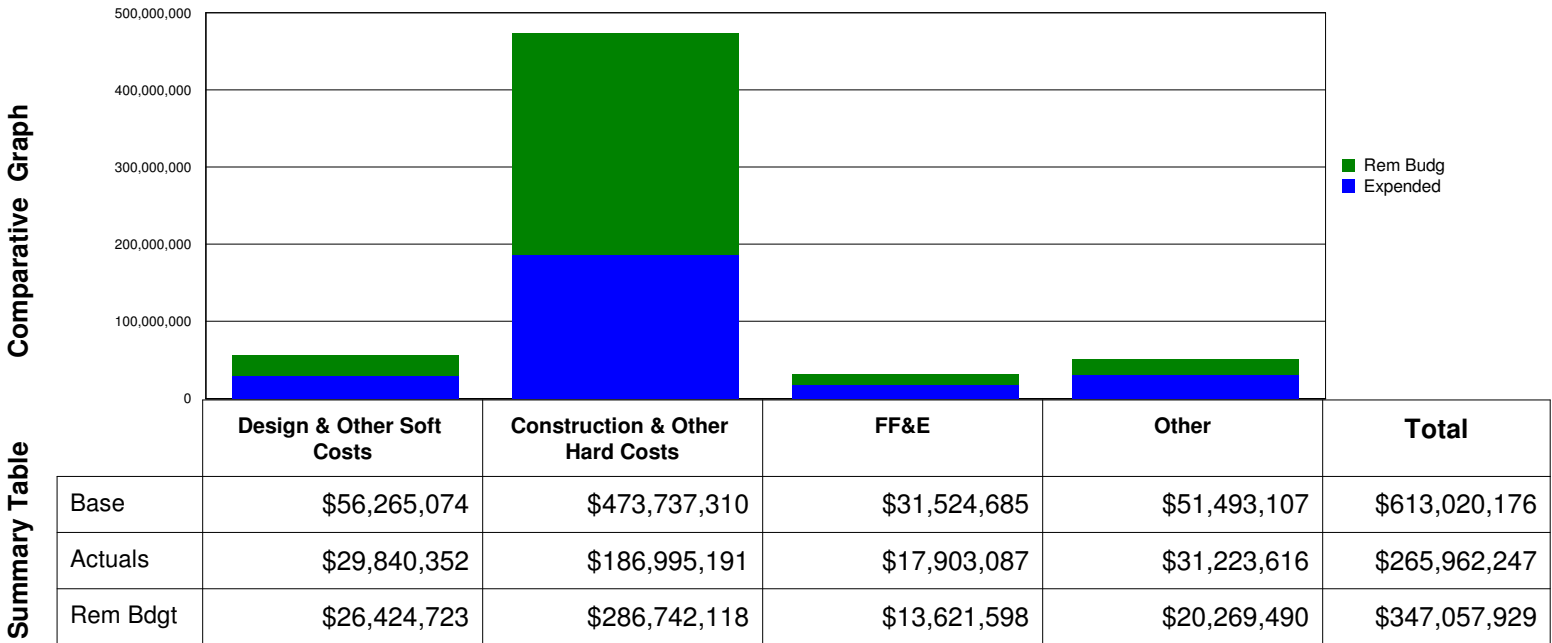
Los Angeles Tradetech College

Description:

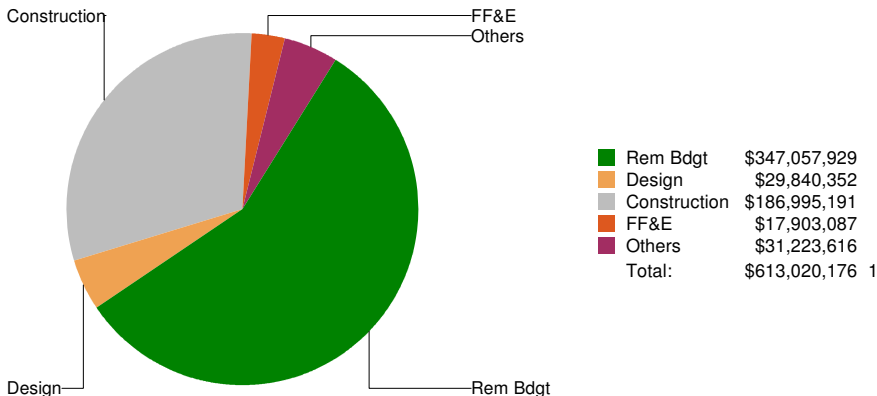

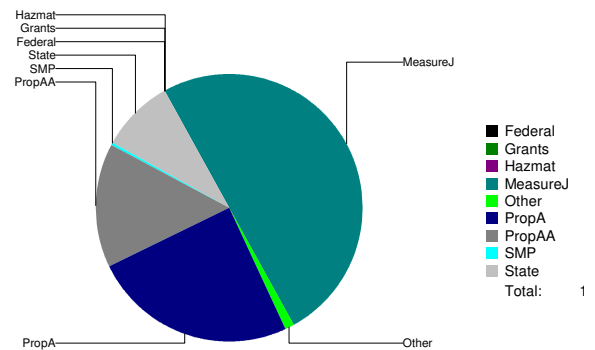

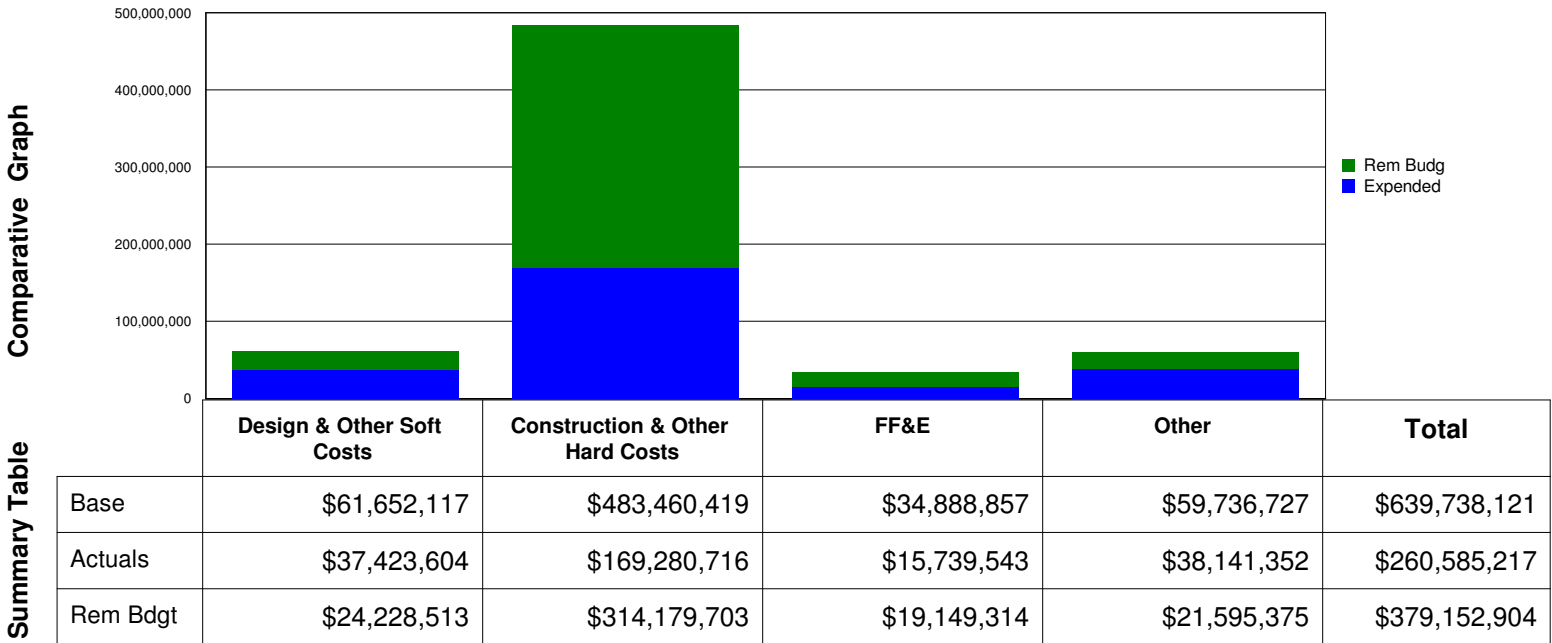
Los Angeles Valley College

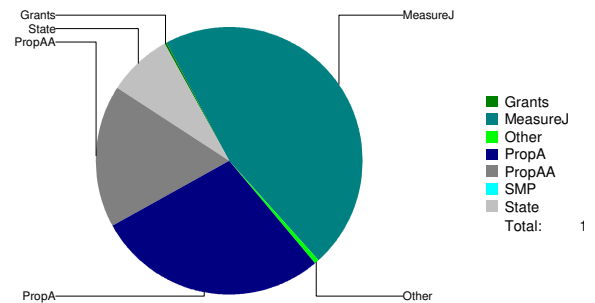
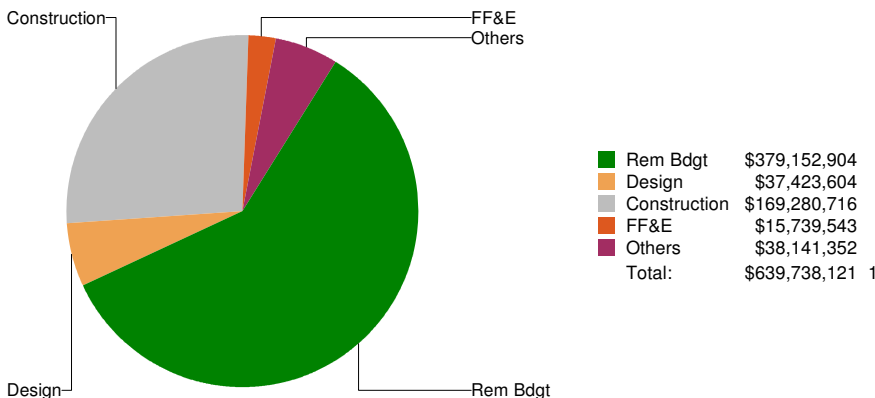

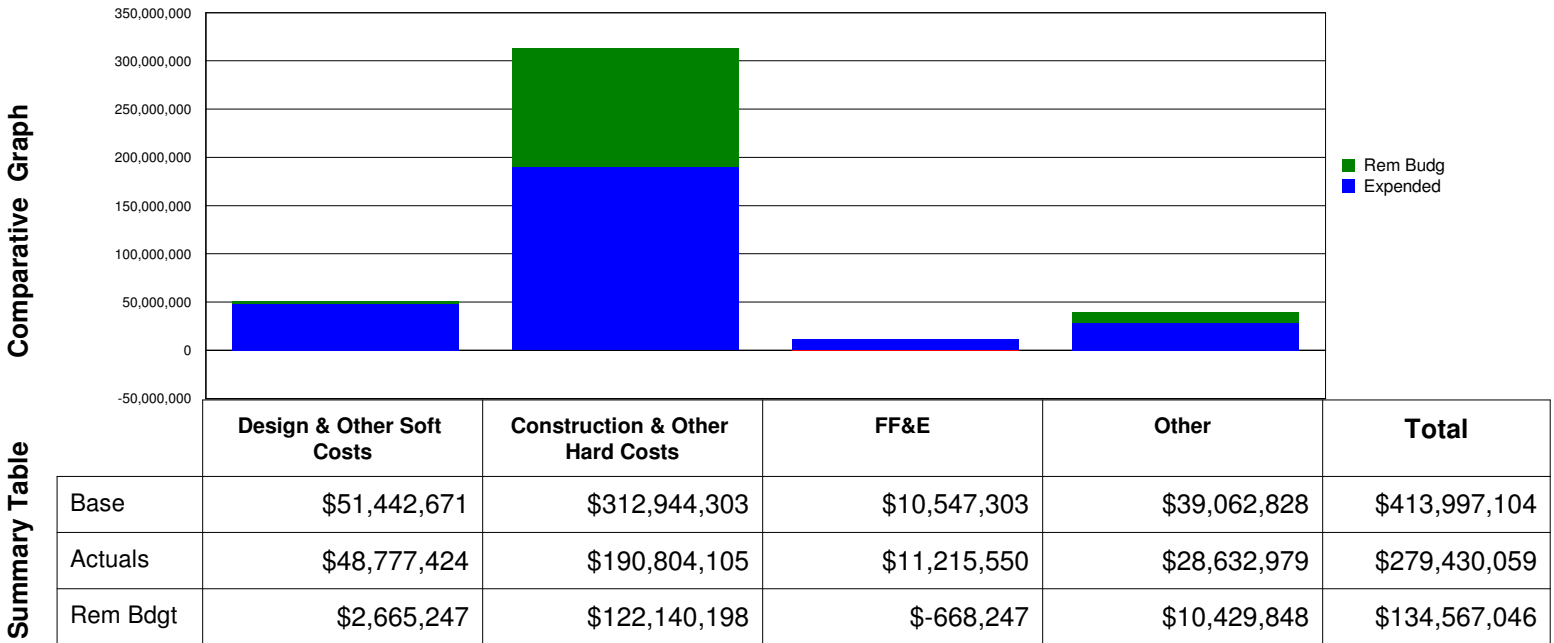
West Los Angeles College

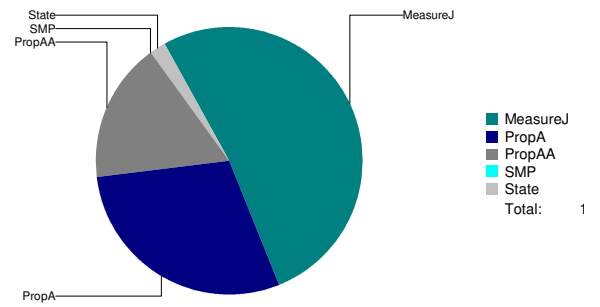
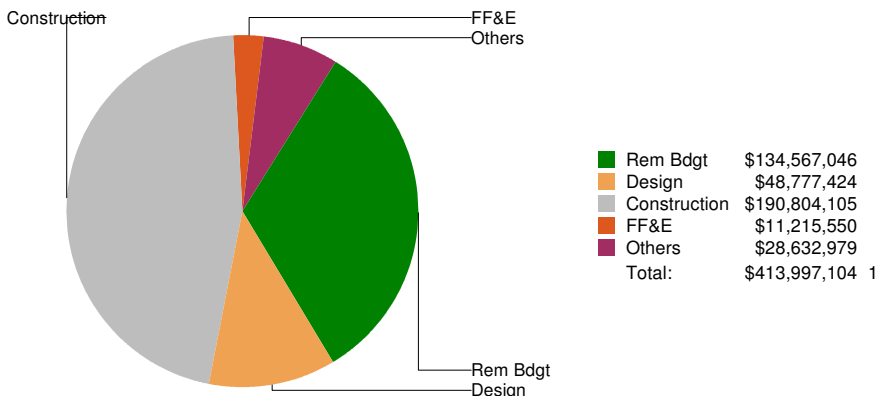

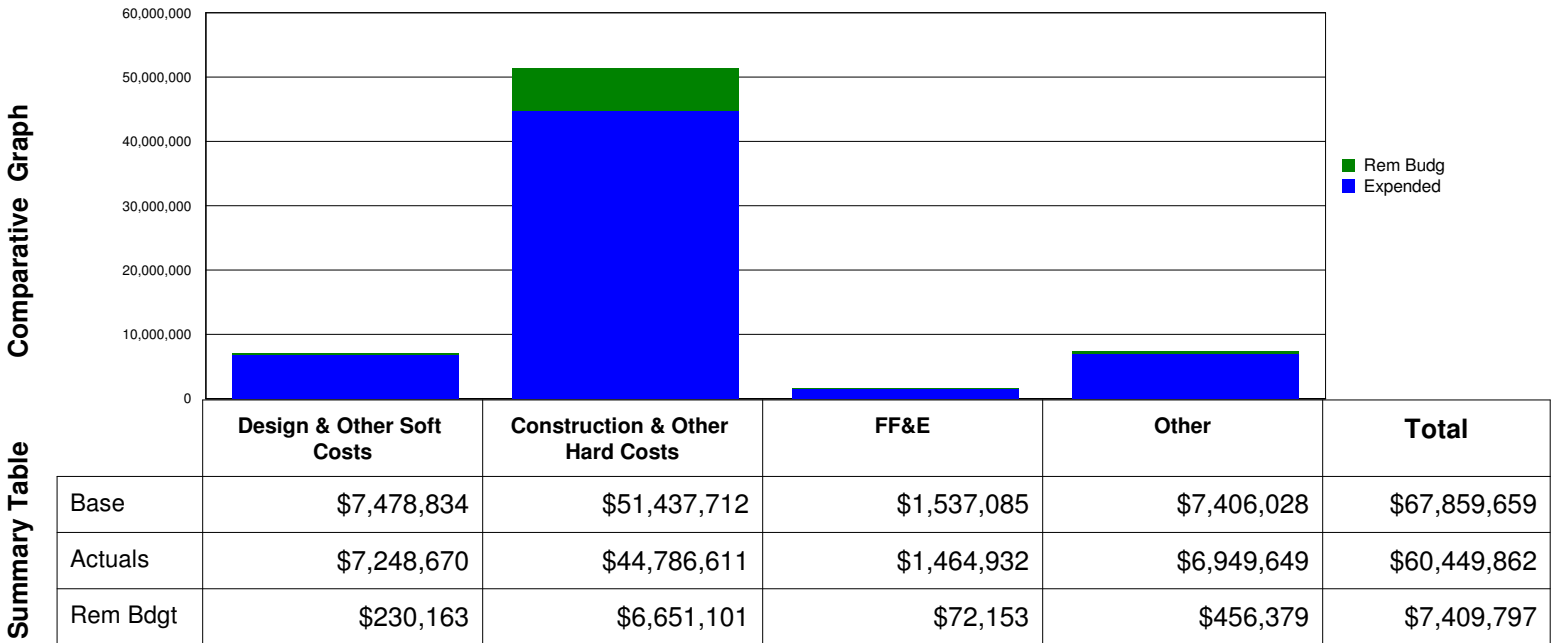
LACCD Van de Kamp Innovation Center
