The Los Angeles Trade Technical College's (LATTC) new \$77.8 million South Campus Project will modernize and upgrade one of the region's leading technical colleges located in Downtown Los Angeles.

- The South Campus Project is the second largest construction venture in the Los Angeles Community College District's Prop. A/AA Bond Construction Program.
- The highlight of the project is **two new five-story buildings**, which will house
 - Technology Classrooms (approximately 66,228 sq. ft.)
 - Student Services (approximately 56,302 sq. ft.)
- Other features of the South Campus project include:
 - A utility building (approximately 1800 sq. ft.)
 - Extensive landscaping

Green Features

- Both buildings are set to be built to the US Green Building Council's LEED-Silver rating (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) standards.
- Some of the methods with which the South Campus Project is targeting LEED certification include:
 - Implementation of Optimized Energy Performance and CFC and HCFC Free Equipment, Construction Waste Management and Recycled and Local Materials Use, Indoor Air Quality and Chemical Control, Low-Emitting Materials, Commissioning of HVAC, Electrical and BAS systems, and connection to the planned Campus Photovoltaic Array.
